## ADAM LENART

Adam Lenart, (b. 1973 in Trzebnica, Poland) studied organ performance under Andrzej Chorościński at the Wrocław Academy of Music and graduated with distinction.

His outstanding achievements earned him admission to the organ soloist class led by Anders Riber at the Jutland Music Conservatory of Aarhus, Denmark, where he graduated with Copenhagen and Aarhus debut recitals in 1998.

Awarding the DAAD scholarship enabled him to study under Professor Gerhard Weinberger at the Detmold College of Music, where he completed his church music studies with the highest-level exams.

Following his studies in Poland and Germany, Mr Lenart has also shown great interest in historical performance studies, both in organ and harpsichord repertoire.

He serves as an organist in Morsbach (Westerwald), in Cologne vicinity - and appears regularly as a concert organist internationally.

Adam Lenart has been honored awards at international organ competitions, i.e., the Feliks Nowowiejski Prize in Poznan; the Frank Martin Prize for the best interpretation of this composer's Passacaglia in Saint-Maurice, Switzerland, and the First Prize/Hermann Schroeder Prize in the Trier Cathedral.

Recently, he has recorded an all-Mendelssohn CD with the three Preludes and Fugues for Organ, Op. 37, along with his own organ arrangement of the six Preludes and Fugues for Piano, Op. 35, on the new Paschen Organ of the Martin Luther church in Detmold for the renowned classical label Dabringhaus and Grimm.
